I never thought I'd find love in Florida. But I did. I found love, I found a home, and I found myself. Florida is a magical place, and I'm so grateful that I get to call it my home.

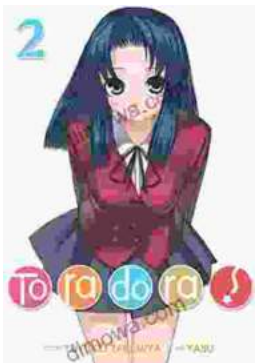

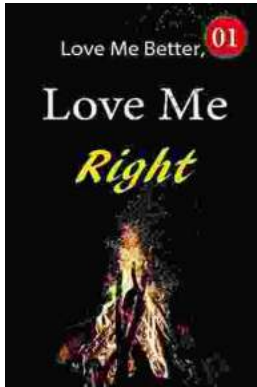
